I had no time to listen to the umpteenth mono-thematic reproach of my mother. Apocalypse Snow was broadcasting on TV and I was completely astonished. It was 1983, I was 9 years old and the protagonists' evolutions in the snow with skis and snowboards of that docu-film, had caught my concentration.

That episode marked my double destiny, the nominal and the professional one: me, Sandy, with bare feet, I wanted a snowboards all mine.

It took me 30 years, working in the trade to get to know the market, collaborating with artisans to learn and create prototypes, challenging me on the snowy slopes to improve my performances, training snowboarding teams to participate in the World Championships up to the Olympics. It took me 30 years but I had what I wanted from my boards: aesthetics, functionality and performance.


This is my work's key: to bring a story, mine story, first as a snowboarder and surfer, and then as a craftsman, within the illusion of living the origins epic, when everything was still – and only – human enterprise. I do this repurposing the models and the natural materials that draw on those "flavors", through the avant-garde "knowledge" and the most advanced technological research. First of all I do it for myself, according to my creativity to improve my performances, then dialoguing, sharing – often anticipating – moods and feelings of those I encounter "on the field" of mutual passions.

## THE COMPANY

#### PEOPLE

In a life dedicated to the innovation and thanks to the intuitions and experiences gained on the ski slopes and in winter sports companies, Alessandro Marchi "Sandy" creates Sandy Shapes, a young company that produces snowboard completely made in Italy, and based in the Friuli Venezia Giulia region.

Years spent on the slopes testing and above all listening to the riders and their needs: all the boards have their own history and a path from which they have been developed, in a constructive philosophy that starts right from the people.

And being people remain at the center of our work. We are not an artisanal workshop, but we are not even a large industrial reality. We can still afford to be a group of people, with ideas and passions to share, before identifying ourselves as workers with skills.

#### PERFORMANCE

Italian design has always been recognized all over the world for being 'well made'; in our work we try to honor this principle and cultivate it in every aspect.

The artisan skills linked to the competitiveness of the Italian industrial system have allowed us to create a company whose performances stand out on the global scene.

Ours is a completely independent and local production, a modern craftsmanship which provides for a thoughtful use of technology and leaves ample room for manual work. A modern craftsmanship that becomes the key to create products with unique performances by meticulously controlling their quality and allowing their replicability, and obtain result that can not be reproduced in industrial production processes or in traditional artisanal processes.

#### PLANET

Being a completely independent production we have an advantage, we can afford more radical and faster choices. We have total control of each construction phase, we can experiment, carefully choose and optimize the materials and waste, personally manage time and energy...

Our method focuses on the production of fewer but higher quality products, differentiating ourself from an industrial consumerist logic, in which quantity is fundamental. For us, quality does not compromise with quantity, and is essential for sustainability.

We would not be here to produce and sell snowboards on which we base our lives, if we did not have our planet at heart. If we want to continue doing what we love and allow future generations to enjoy the same opportunities, sustainability must be our foundation.





#### **FUTURE MATERIALS**

We are experimenting with different solutions, and with excellent results, using natural linen fibre instead of the classic glass and carbon fibre, and replacing the standard epoxy glue with different bio-resins that can reach 70% of natural origin.


We are already working also to replace the bamboo we use for the sidewalls with a recycled bamboo. In this way we would be able to use production waste from other processes and industries, partially compensating for its already intensive use.



#### CIRCULAR ECONOMY

Our goal is clear and we continue to experiment in order to reach an extensive (and hopefully complete) use of materials of natural or recycled origin, and make our product part of a circular economy.

Together with research centers and consortia at local and international level, we are developing the concrete possibility of reusing all the scraps and components, decomposing it to create a new circular material.



## around the timeless beauty of the wood, beyond the seasonality of serial products

Wood evolution™ is a composite material derived from natural wood which evolves, thanks to a particular patented process. This technology allows us to use a real wood topsheet without compromising the functionality of the boards, increasing their performances and durability and making the product more sustainable, totally eliminating the use of common plastic materials and inks.

Thanks to its natural diversity, each piece of wood is unique, and at the same time does not change over the years, it has a timeless beauty. Hence the decision not to have different collections over the years, moving away from a consumerist logic, eliminating the seasonality of a product and all the problems related. In our snowboards wood takes a leading role: it is not only an aesthetic factor, it is the choice of a symbolic material, a tribute to the origins of this sport, and an encouragement to a different way of living and practicing it.





For our finishes we refer to an Italian company leader in this field that guarantees us a raw material of the best quality: all the wood are certified and comes from legal forests, as well as the different colors through which it is dyed in the thickness for a perfect homogeneity. After years of testing we have chosen the walnut and ash wood type, natural or stained, and a special variant, the Abonos TM fossil wood.



#### **CUSTOMIZATION**

As we do with our logo, the laser technology allows us to engrave the Wood Evolution surface creating drawings, dedications, initials...

In this way we avoid the use of inks and prints of any kind, and we can customize both a single piece and a custom series on request.



#### **MAINTANANCE**

Our finish is obtained through the application of an experimented mixture of natural oils and waxes. To protect the surface it is important to take care of it whenever necessary with the provided Beauty Care Treatment Kit, that can be used for the periodic surface maintenance, to repair scratches and to "feed" the wood, through the sanding pad and the treatment.

## PRESS METHOD



As well as the slow cooking of foods ensures the best results, the same happens in the Sandy Shapes snowboards: with our press method all the ingredients keep their properties intact and blend perfectly. That's why all our boards seems to be softer than the industrial ones, but at the same time they don't lose performance and even their durability increases.

This is an important factor that differentiate us from an industrial production: we use a slow-cooking method that is not suitable for a large-scale, since a snowboard production time increases considerably. We have very simple and minimal presses, which does not require automation or the use of water and oils, that are heated slowly and left to cool naturally, consuming less energy and respecting the materials inside them.

## WOODCORE PROFILES

#### NEGATIVE CORE PROFILE

The negative core profile is characterized by a reverse thickness, increased in correspondence of the feet position and thinned at the ends and in the center of the snowboard. It is ideal on wide boards and to increase the sensitivity under the feet, guaranteeing a great leg independence.

#### POSITIVE CORE PROFILE

This profile is given by an increase in thickness of the wooden core that starts from the tip and tail to reach the maximum height under the feet, keeping it constant at the center of the snowboard. This way we get powerful and stable boards oriented to speed and we reinforce the splitboards internal edge for the ascents.

#### MULTISTRINGER

The board's woodcore is made with thinner wood strips in the outer part, close to the sidewalls. This technology allows to recreate real surfing sensations, giving a good bending and make the board extremely pleasant underfoot, also in wider boards, despite their big sizes.

The combination of Ash and Paulownia stringers follow the sidecut of every board. Every core follow the radius of every model.

This structure transmits more force to the edges requiring less energy from the rider. Translates more efficiency.

This combination of woods controls flexibility and torsion in a unique and precious way



## MORE GRIP, LESS VIBRATIONS

All the "X EVO" boards have really high edge grip compared to straight stringers woodcores.

But the real important innovation are the rubber layers between the woods.

Our R&D always search for new solutions.

The rubbers decrease radically the vibrations from the edges to the bindings through the board.

A new generation of performances that expresses itself best on all terrains and in particular on hard and very hard snow.

## SHAPES







#### TWIN TIP

A twin-tip is a symmetric shape between tip and tail, that can be used in both directions as the rider is perfectly centered. Born as a freestyle geometry, today it is used also for all-mountain boards, thanks to its ease of use and stability.

#### DIRECTIONAL

Directional boards are focused to give their best in one direction. The tip is longer and wider than the tail and the bindings are moved backwards from 2cm in the all-mountain boards to 8cm in powder boards. Directional boards are versatile but find their best environment carving on the slopes and in powder.

#### RADIUS NOT RADIUS

This sidecut was born from an existing project, where the circular arcs have been replaced by straight lines. With this solution the pressure is uniformly distributed over the entire length of the edge. A board with this technology will be the best choice for maximum grip on hard surfaces.

## SHAPES







#### FAKE TWIN TIP

Our fake twin-tip keeps the same sidecut of a twin-tip snowboard but has a different tail and tip, which make this board versatile in all-mountain and more suitable for all the snow conditions. The shorter and flattened tail improves maneuverability and handling even on large boards, and combined with a wider tip it favors floating in fresh snow, while maintaining the playful character of a twin-tip.


#### **SWALLOW TAIL**

A swallowtail snowboard is characterized by a V-tail which, as the name says, resembles that of a swallow or a fish, taking inspiration from the surfing world. It is an ideal shape for fresh snow, where the shape of the tail and its reduced volume, combined with an average wide nose and the setback, facilitate the snow passage under the board and gives floatation and 'surf feeling' even in the deepest powder.


#### RADUCTION

Concept and construction introduced by Burton, that allows you to use a snowboard 8-10 cm shorter than your normal size. A board apparently small but with great performance and for maximum fun: its size and lightness make it easy to control and perfect also for learning, from carving to tricks, while its particular structure guarantees a stability and grip equal to those of a normal board.

## SHAPE PROFILES







#### ROCKER


The line is a soft and continuous ellipse in the entire length, that produces a very responsive board with a great versatility, fast when turning and ollieing, with a good floatation on fresh snow. Definitely a very versatile choice, suitable both for beginners and freestyle lovers.

#### MICROCAMBER

The arch extends in the binding area becoming flat before reaching the tip and tail, then it rises up with a very wide radius. It is a highly responsive and accurate profile for those who wants a great edge grip on hard snow and a powerful board when ollieing. This profile is recommended for more experienced riders.

#### FREERIDE PROFILE

The camber is positioned under the feet, which it has been moved backwards from 2 to 8 cm. The tip, longer than the tail, has a very soft rocker curve while the tail has a short radius one. It is an all-mountain directional profile, ideal for carving on fresh snow but incredibly agile and responsive also on the slopes.



## MAGNIFICA

The word "Magnifica" means extraordinary, magnificent [from the Latin magnificus, composed of magnus, big, and facere, to do]. "Magnifico" is who has and shows magnificence, greatness, nobility and generosity. It refers also to what generally expresses admiration, as an emphatic equivalent of beautiful, excellent, wonderful.

Magnifica is a board that express magnificence in everything it does, with an innate ability to stands out and be admired in every context! A 'European' swallow-tail board with a reduced width in the center and a straighter shape. The profile and the flex have been designed to recreate the sensations of surfing and have a perfect floatation in powder, while the reinforcements and the sidecut give it our famous edge grip on hard ground, with carbon reinforcements in the tail that act as "accelerators" to increase the speed at every turn. Who says that a swallow-tail cannot be a primary board was wrong, and Magnifica is able to prove it.

## REGINA

The word "Regina" means queen [from the Latin regīna, derived from rex regis, king]. "Regina" is the king's wife, or the woman who reigns. But can be also a woman who stands out for some qualities.

Regina is the boards queen, the one to whose passage everybody bow! A board available in two sizes, designed for those who love speed and surf feeling. The size 170 is wider and more powerful, the size 180 slimmer and faster, like the "Hawaiian gun" for the steepest waves. They are unique boards, ready to be surfed in the best days leaving unforgettable memories, emotions and feelings, and then to be jealously guarded in your quiver!

### DIVINA

The word "Divina" means divine, heavenly, celestial, perfect [from the Latin divinus, derived from divus = deus, god]. "Divino" is who or what has the nature and the essence of God, or which has in some way a relationship with divinity. As a hyperbole means also noble, sublime, excellent, perfect, beautiful.

You don't need other words to describe this board, with Divina you'll feel like you are surfing in paradise! Maneuverability, low weight and a crazy edge grip at the same time, with an incredible floatation in powder thanks to the rounded nose and the generous width of 27.5 cm at the center. A playful board inspired by the "San Diego fish surfboards", with all the technical specifications that characterize a Sandy Shapes snowboard and make it performing despite its small size.

## RIBELLE CAMBER

The word "Ribelle" means disobedient, rebellious [from the Latin rebellis, derived from the verb rebellare: to rebel]. It is an adjective for who rise against authority, rejecting obedience and submission. A "Ribelle" is indocile and shows impatience to external constraints or impositions.

Ribelle is exactly like this, an undisciplined board for rebel riders, that don't like schemes and conventions and love to do what they wants. Thanks to the "raduction" concept it is very light and maneuverable, but hides the performance of a larger board thanks to structural elements such as carbon stripes and ash inserts. The camber model is "poppy", more demanding and precise, while remaining very pleasant underfoot and surprisingly floating. Choose the size from 6 to 10cm shorter than a standard board and be prepared: this tiny twin-tip board, apparently harmless, hide a very strong character!



## BIRBANTE

Not a toy, but a real snowboard for children and teens who take it seriously.

To develop this board we took inspiration from our Ribelle model, changing only its size and profile but maintaining the same construction as an adults snowboard. A snowboard suitable for progression and should not be underestimated: small and light it is incredibly playful and responsive, while remaining always manageable and stable to provide safety to the young rider. From the slope with the family to the park with friends, this little snowboard will accompany him everywhere.

## ZINGARA

The word "Zingara" means gipsy, rover [Italian adaption of the names Atsigan and then Tsigan, attributed to the Gypsies as an adaptation of the Greek  $A9i\gamma\alpha\nu\sigma$ ]. Literally "Zingaro" is someone belonging to the ethnic group of Gypsies, and with this reference it is used in the common language referring to a nomadic life.

Zingara is an allmoutain twin tip board that loves to travel, designed to explore the world: from the most famous snow parks, to the heliskiing trips, or simply in the local ski area... it will always follow you and will never disappoint you! It is a very unique twin-tip all-mountain, with an incredible flotation and a high edge grip, with it you can move from extreme carving to powder. A progressive flex combined with a modern microcamber and a shape with a light nose and tail scoop, that make it suitable for any snow and slope condition, easy to manage in any situation, but able to always satisfy even the most demanding riders.

The ash and paulownia wood stringers follow the sidecut and give more distribuited pressure along the edges. The all moutain twin tip become more technical with increased edge grip and pop power. Some riders love this version also for high end freestyle where edges power is very important.

## AMARA

The word "Amara" means bitter [From the Latin amarus]. "Amaro" is one of the four basic taste sensations, with sweet, salty and acid. It is a particular and strong taste, often pungent and penetrating, it can be annoying to the senses and it is not for everyone, so much that sometimes is used as an opposite of sweetness.

Amara is definitely not a sweet board: strong and demanding, will charm those who are able to understand and use its incredible potential! The shape is the same of the Audace but the microcamber profile makes this board more structured, suitable for expert riders with good technique. It maintains a freestyle inclination but is also extraordinary on groomed snow and in icy conditions thanks to the grip given by the 'radius not radius'. The flex distribution, soft between the feet and more rigid at the nose and tail, keeps it stable at high speeds and allows precise and explosive ollies.

## CURIOSA

After years of twin tip all-mountain boards we are going back to the roots. Starting from Zingara, we've redesigned the shape with a light tapered profile, 7mm narrower on each tail side while keeping the same nose. A shorter tail completes the outline of Curiosa.

When choosing your size, opt for a board 4 cm shorter than Zingara.

With an innovative profile that maintains the camber in twin tip position while redefining the fake twin directional shape, Curiosa delivers a unique riding experience.

Designed both for on- and off-piste, encouraging modern stances and new performances. A new dedicated wood core makes this board truly unique.

If, after years of snowboarding, you're still curious and craving fresh sensations, Curiosa is your perfect ride.

The word "Deliziosa" means delicious, adorable, wonderful [from the Latin deliciosus]. "Delizioso" is something that gives delight, a spiritual, aesthetic or physical enjoyment, and also something that taste or smell pleasant, exquisite.

Deliziosa is an adorable board with a curvy shape: despite its small size and the big width it is incredibly smooth and agile, pleasant in every terrain and wonderful in every discipline! The small size makes it easy to handle, the microcamber enhances its edge grip and pop, while the large surface and the fake-twin tip shape give it an excellent floatation. Deliziosa is certainly one of our most versatile models, which completes our line-up of "raducted" boards, in order to respond to extra width requests, being generous with its 27.5 cm in the center.

## EGOISTA

The word "Egoista" means selfish, self-centered [from the Latin ego, me]. Selfish is who sins of selfishness, the attitude of one who cares only about himself, for his well-being and his own usefulness, excluding anyone else.

So why this board's name is Egoista? It's simple: because when this board is on the slope, wants all the slope for itself! The generous extra width at the center and the peculiar shape with a large blunt nose and a soft moon-tail, combined with our freeride profile, increase the flotation at any speed, while ash structural elements and the positive core profile make this board performant also on groomed snow. Egoista is a "raducted" board in 3 sizes included extra wide version.

## VIRTUOSA

## RIBELLE ROCKER




